## 2018 Mahaska County Little League Baseball Pitcher Eligibility Tracking Form

- 1. Managers MUST record, for each game played, each pitch a pitcher throws during a game and MUST have Chief Umpire and opposing team's Manager sign this form *in ink* within 30 minutes of completion of game. Umpires will expect this request, but it is the Manager's responsibility. Umpire may initial for opposing Manager if that person refuses to sign or leaves w/out signing form. Max. number of pitches thrown by a pitcher varies by age: 7-8, 50 pitches/day; 9-10, 75 pitches/day; 11-12, 85 pitches/day, per LLB Regs. See mandatory rest requirements in the LL Baseball Rule Book.
- 2. Managers MUST have this form, with required signatures, listing all innings pitched for previous games during any game they are playing.
- 3. Managers MUST bring this completed form to All Star selections if a pitcher is to be selected from this team for a Majors or Minors All-Star team.
- 4. Pitching rules are continuously applied and don't vary. If there are double-headers or three or more games in a week due to rainouts, the required rest & eligibility is not changed, nor expanded. Regular season baseball pitching rules are in the LL Baseball Rule Book (see Regulation VI -- Pitchers).
- 5. A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of the day.
- 6. When throwing the following number of pitches, the number of days rest must be attained: 1-20 pitches in a day, 0 calendar days of rest; 21-35 pitches, 1 calendar day of rest; 36-50 pitches in a day, 2 calendar days of rest; 51-65 pitches in a day, 3 calendar days of rest; 66 or more, 4 calendar days of rest. **Exception**: If a pitcher reaches a day(s) rest threshold while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until any one of the following conditions occurs:
- 1: That batter reaches base; 2: That batter is retired; 3: The third out is made to complete the half-inning or the game. The pitcher will only be required to observe the calendar day(s) of rest for the threshold he reached during that at-bat, provided that pitcher is removed or the game is completed before delivering a pitch to another batter.
- 7. Any player who has played the position of catcher in 4 or more innings (all or part of) is not eligible to pitch on that calendar day (Reg. VI (a))
- 8. Failure to follow these rules will result in forfeiture of a prior game without required signatures, or any game with an ineligible pitcher. -- MCLL
